Terms & Conditions:

The terms and conditions for this exhibition apply to Northland Artists who wish to submit an entry to the Multicultural Art Exhibition at Reyburn House.

These terms and conditions must be read, accepted and signed before any artwork can be exhibited.

The NSA Council decides:

1. The dates and length of time of the exhibition.
2. The exhibition fees.
3. Whether an artwork is suitable for display.
4. What artwork is chosen for publicity purposes.
5. How the exhibition is presented.

The Artist must ensure:

1. All artwork adheres to the size requirement of 1mtr x 1.5mtr (100cm x 150cm / 1000mm x 1500mm). Any piece outside these parameters will not be eligible to hang and therefore rejected.
2. All artwork is strung and ready to hang as per the instructions provided.
3. All artwork is clearly labelled with their name, the title of the piece and medium used, using a large price tag attached to the wire by string. Claw hangers are not permitted.
4. The hanging fee for each piece of art is paid in full at time of registration.
5. The artwork is available for promotional purpose

The Artist is aware:

1. The Northland Society of Arts accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of any exhibit, during transit or while the work is in Reyburn House Art Gallery.
2. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.
3. Artwork that is sold attracts a 25% commission plus GST on that commission.
4. Unsold artwork must be collected on the Monday after the exhibition closes, between 9am-1pm, unless prior arrangements have been made.

Deliver your artwork to the Gallery during opening hours any time during the week before the exhibition opens.

- Week to deliver: 1st – 6th July
- Opening Event: 8th July (fully catered event)
- Collect any unsold artwork: 3rd August, 2-4pm
